# A Note From Fr. Bob

Dear Friends,

Grace and peace to you!

This past week Archbishop Mitchell Rozanski announced that he is lifting the dispensation to attend Sunday Mass effective July 1, 2021. While these continue to be uncertain times for everyone, we want to ensure that all feel safe when returning to Mass. Therefore, those who are sick, homebound, immune-compromised, and gravely concerned for their health retain the dispensation from the obligation to attend Sunday Mass. Many people are unaware, but this has always been the case in normal times. If one is sick, then please, stay home. If one is homebound, call us, we will bring the church and communion to you. If you have grave concerns for your health, please wait to return until your concerns have been satisfied. In the meantime, if you wish to receive communion, call us, we will make arrangements.

As a reminder, those who have not received a vaccine for COVID should follow CDC guidelines for mask use and social distancing. We ask all to be thoughtful of your own health and that of the community in monitoring yourself for COVID-19 symptoms. Masks remain optional for those who are fully vaccinated. We will continue to provide hand sanitizer and encourage its use for all. All Eucharistic Ministers will wear masks during the distribution of Holy Communion so long as those who wear masks are present. The distribution of the Chalice of the Precious Blood during Holy Communion remains prohibited until further notice from the USCCB.

As the dispensation is lifted, we will also return many of our pre-pandemic practices in our worship together. This means that choirs will return; hymnals and missalettes will return to the pews; offertory baskets and the Offertory Procession will return; Eucharistic Ministers to assist with the distribution of Holy Communion will return; all these will require your help. We will be contacting previous volunteers shortly. If you have never been a Eucharistic Minister, Hospitality Minister, Lector, or member of the Choir, please contact us at the parish office, we would be grateful for your help.

If you have any concerns about the lifting of the dispensation of the obligation to attend Sunday Mass, please contact me.

This week, something is going to happen that will give you the opportunity to touch someone's life with God's love. Watch for it.

If you consciously choose to make the most of the situation, you might feel challenged, perhaps a bit nervous or intimidated, but you will experience the joy of making a difference for the kingdom of God. And you might be surprised at how well you do!

God has been preparing you for this situation for a long time. Your trials, your spiritual education, your personal purification process, your prayer-time insights, your Christ-centered conversations with others – all these and more have been part of the preparation.

You are like the seed in the Gospel passage. Life's circumstances have fertilized

you, watered you, and tilled your soil. Over time, the seed sprouted, the plant grew, and the flowers began to produce good fruit.

Every day, we all encounter small and sometimes large opportunities to serve the kingdom of God. We don't have to be full-time volunteers nor paid employees of the Church to work in the mission of Christ. If we are willing, he touches the world through us in our homes, our workplaces, our parishes, in the grocery store, in the traffic tie-ups, on the Internet, and everywhere we go.



Have any of your seeds sprouted into a tree that withered from neglect or got chopped down by others? This happens to all of us. The good news is: In every dead tree at least one fruit remains, shriveled up and hanging

from a lifeless branch, but secretly holding a very valuable seed.

We are to take those ugly, dead fruits and plant them in the freshly tilled soil of today. A new tree will grow and it will become taller and stronger and more abundantly fruitful than the tree from which it came, because the decay from the original tree is now additional fertilizer in the soil.

In everything that happens to you, remember: You have good fruits to share; God has been nurturing their growth. You are ready!

### Reflect & Discuss:

1. What are some of the ways you have grown in your faith? How can this help others?
2. Realizing that the good fruit that come from your growth is Jesus working through you to make the world a better place, how do you feel about this?
3. Describe various ways that we continue the mission of Christ in our ordinary lives.
4. What produces new growth in us so that we become more useful to Christ?

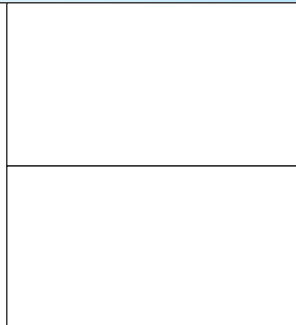
