

Holy Spirit Parish Covid-19 Update

In response to the St. Louis County Mask update and in accordance with the updated Archdiocesan mandates for COVID mitigation, beginning with Mass this weekend, only those who are unvaccinated are required to wear a mask while attending Mass in our church. Social distancing is no longer required for the vaccinated. So that we might continue to provide a safe place to worship for all, every other pew will remain closed for the time being. The dispensation to attend Sunday Mass remains in place so that if one is uncomfortable attending Mass then they may continue to watch our Mass on our YouTube live-stream at 9:00 am on Sundays and weekdays.

While the mask requirement for those who are unvaccinated is mandatory, it is to be observed on the honor system. No one will check to see if anyone has been vaccinated. Since the mask requirement has been dropped for the vaccinated, it is still an option. If you are uncomfortable going without a mask, please wear it. Father Jerry, the deacons, and I will continue to wear a mask during the distribution of Holy Communion. We will revisit opening all the pews in a few weeks.

The mitigation practices in our school will remain in place and unchanged through the end of this school year.
