Objective and Design:

- Align tuition support with “continued Catholic community-building” among high school students which extends throughout their lives.
- Annual participation in a service opportunity and a faith experience, sponsored by the Roman Catholic Foundation, which will build the Fellows’ identity as a group of young Catholic leaders.

Guidelines:

- Preference will be given to families registered in a parish of the Archdiocese of St. Louis.
- Awards will be granted to new and existing students in ninth through twelfth grade.
- Awards renew through graduation, upon annual re-qualification and active participation in the Fellows Program.
- Awards transfer should the student transfer to another eligible school within the Archdiocese of St. Louis.
- Maximum of one *Beyond Sunday* award per family per school. Families may be eligible for additional scholarship awards through other programs.
- Minimum annual tuition payment of \$1,000 per student is required. If award plus required minimum tuition exceeds total tuition, award amount shall be the remainder of tuition after minimum payment is subtracted.
- Applicants are required to write a brief essay as part of the *Beyond Sunday* Fellows application. They must also provide contact information for Catholic and educational leaders who may be contacted to provide a reference.

Additional Information:

- An estimated 35 new awards will be granted in ninth grade; between 1 and 5 new awards will be granted in each remaining grade (tenth through twelfth), with the fewest new awards in tenth grade.
- An estimated 120 students awarded in 2016-2017 will requalify for 2017-2018 scholarships.

Objective and Design:

- Provide tuition support to increase access to Catholic education for middle-income families.

Guidelines:

- Preference will be given to families registered in a parish of the Archdiocese of St. Louis.
- Awards will be granted to new and existing students in kindergarten through eighth grade.
- Awards renew through 8th grade graduation, upon annual re-qualification.
- Awards transfer should the student transfer to another eligible school within the Archdiocese of St. Louis.
- Maximum of one *Beyond Sunday* award per family per school. Families may be eligible for additional scholarship awards through other programs.
- Minimum annual tuition payment of \$500 per student is required. If award plus required minimum tuition exceeds total tuition, award amount shall be the remainder of tuition after minimum payment is subtracted.

Additional Information:

- An estimated 140 new awards will be granted in kindergarten; between 5 and 60 new awards will be granted in each remaining grade (first through eighth), with the fewest new awards in first grade.
- An estimated 750 students awarded in 2016-2017 will requalify for 2017-2018 scholarships.

2017-18 Scholarship Application available on January 30th

***Deadline for Beyond Sunday, SOAR!,
Catholic Families Tuition Assistance, and
Parish Employees Endowment Fund is February 28th!***

Any family who would like to be considered for these programs, **even if you are applying for requalification** for one of these scholarships, must apply between January 30th and February 28th, 2017. Also, it is important to remember that Alive! In Christ is first-come, first-served, so we are encouraging all families to apply as early as possible.

IMPORTANT ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- If you have ever applied to TTEF before or are currently on scholarship, you must use the email address we have on file for you. If you do not know what this email address is, please email our office at ttef@archstl.org or call us at 314-792-7777. If you know what your email address is but forgot your password, please visit the family login page and click Forgot Password below the family login box. The Family Login Page can be accessed through our website, www.ttef-stl.org and clicking on Apply Here.
- Individual students may not receive more than one scholarship if awarded. However, Catholic Families Tuition Assistance and Parish Employees Endowment Fund are tuition aid programs that may be awarded in addition to another scholarship. Families may have multiple children receiving scholarships.
- Documents needed to complete applications include:
 - High School Students are required to submit an essay and contact information for two references at the time of application to be considered for the *Beyond Sunday* Fellows Program. Students already receiving a *Beyond Sunday* Fellows scholarship are not required to submit an essay or references for requalification.
 - ESSAY PROMPT: In 250 words, please describe why you want to be a *Beyond Sunday* Fellow.
 - REFERENCES: One from your pastor or leader of a Catholic program or organization of which the applicant is a member, and the other from a teacher or principal. Please provide only the contact information for your references and do not submit letters of recommendation. Your references will only be contacted if necessary.
 - Proof of residency (St. Louis City residents only)
 - Proof of Income
